### 2010 PAMMA Dart Tournament *Fabulous Turnout!*

Carlisle, PA - The fourth annual P.A.M.M.A. dart tournament was held November 19-21 in Carlisle Pennsylvania. Over 220 dart shooters representing leagues in Pennsylvania, Ohio, New Jersey, New York and Maryland traveled to the event held at the Hotel Carlisle in central Pennsylvania. PAMMA offered a \$10 per night per room discount based on staying two nights and shooting in both Saturday and Sunday events as an enticement for players to support the three-day event.

The Pennsylvania Amusement and Music Machine Association hold this fund raising tournament in conjunction with sponsorship from Arachnid Manufacturing and Betson Distributing of Pittsburgh and King of Prussia. The proceeds of the event benefit the state association who represent the coin machine operators in Pennsylvania. PAMMA is celebrating its 30<sup>th</sup> year in serving the coin machine industry this upcoming January 2011.

Cash prizes in excess of the advertised \$11,000 guaranteed payout were spread out over the three-day tournament with contests that covered "Pro division", "A" division and "B" division events. Players participated in singles, doubles, and triple contests to test their skills against other like opponents. This tournament attracts some of the best league players in the region as evidenced by the attendance of renowned shooters such as John Kuczynski, one of the top world ranked players in darts and one of the true ambassadors of the game. John sponsors a very successful "Toys for Tots" campaign every Christmas season at a variety of dart functions and gracefully signed tee shirts purchased at the PAMMA event to benefit this worthy cause. Johnny "K", as he's known in dart circles, raised ten thousand dollars last year and hopes to do the same in 2010. John is typically part of the Arachnid International team that competes worldwide against the very best in the sport. Kathy Karpowich, one of the very best women dart competitors in the country swept Women's Singles, Women's Doubles and also placed first as part of the Mixed Triples event.
